## Recruitment of Consultant for Developing National Cooling Plan

Sri Lanka is a Party to the Montreal Protocol on Substances that deplete Ozone Layer (ODS) since 1989. The National Ozone Unit (NOU) of the Ministry of Mahaweli Development & Environment act as the National Focal Point in implementing the Obligations of Montreal Protocol in Sri Lanka.

Montreal Protocol has adapted environmentally friendly and energy efficient technologies while transitioning away from controlled Ozone depleting substances (ODS) under the Montreal Protocol. Accordingly, many new technologies such as Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) have been introduced by various industries, especially in refrigeration & air conditioning. The Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol was adopted by the Parties to the Montreal Protocol in October 2016 for phase-down of Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), which are not ozone depleting but have high Global Warming Potential (GWP) values. Sri Lanka has completed the process of ratification to the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal on phase-down of Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) and several activities are being implemented in relation to the same.

**Kigali Cooling Efficiency Programme (K-CEP)** is one of the projects approved for Sri Lanka aiming to achieve many objectives including the **preparation of National Cooling Plan (NCP)** for the country, establishing the national strategy to address country's needs in high performance cooling equipment and linking the Montreal Protocol to climate protection efforts, etc

In this context, Ministry of Mahaweli Development & Environment has decided to obtain the service of a Consultant for a maximum of 7 months period to develop National Cooling Plan. Applications are invited from the prospective professionals who possess following qualifications:

- Be a Citizen of Sri Lanka
- Having professional/ academic background in Refrigeration & Air Conditioning or Energy
- Having previous experiences in undertaking of similar assignments (e.g. survey, study projects, project preparation, etc) at the national level.

Familiarity with the Montreal Protocol on ODS and implementing its regulation will be an advantage. Applications are hereby invited from the prospective consultants to undertake the assignment. It is also informed that the selected consultant will be required to sign an agreement with the National Ozone Unit.
